Srinivasa Ramanujan Talent Search Test in Mathematics 2021

National Mathematics Day 2021 is going to be Organized by Bihar Council on Science and Technology, Patna in collaboration with Bihar Mathematical Society on 22 & 23 December 2021 from 10 AM.

1. Aims and objectives of SRTSTM-2021

- The aim of the SRTSTM is to encourage and promote to equip the students for competitive examinations to the young students and to create so much interest for the subject of mathematics.
- To remove phobia of mathematics among teachers and students .

2. Eligibility

A candidate must be a citizen of India. A regular student of a particular class in 2021 from any recognized educational institutions of Bihar will be eligible to appear for the SRTSTM-2021. All candidates are requested to carefully read the Rules of the Examination. The Candidates applying for the examination should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions for admission to Examination. The date of birth and other relevant educational certificates are required to be certified by the principal or head of the institution and submitted only at the time of felicitation or award function.

3. Examination Pattern:

It is an online Objective type Examination with a duration of 1 hour and comprising 30 questions. There will be no negative marking. The question papers will be set both in Hindi and English.

The Test Examination is to be conducted in three levels:

Level 1-	Class 6 to 8
Level 2-	Class 9 & 10
Level 3-	Class 11 & 12

4. Examination Centre

Examinations will be conducted at certain specified towns of Bihar. The Centres and the date of holding the examination as mentioned above are liable to be changed at the discretion of the Board. Candidates admitted to the examination will be informed of the time table and place of examination.

5. Examination Results: The result of SRTSTM-2021 are declared on the official website www.bmsbihar.org and www.bcst.org.in .

6. Medals and Certificates:

Three students will be selected in each participating District i. e, total 9 students and awarded cash prizes Rs1000, Rs 700 and Rs.500 with certificate of excellence and medals who got first, second and third rank respectively.
